Question 1. In reference to GVB IFB 2016-002 MS, under Page 7, No. 5 Bid Package submittal items, letter D, the requirement requests for list of manufacturer source where bag will be produced. We order our bags through an agent in the USA but is manufactured in China. Will providing the agent be satisfactory? Agent may not be willing to provide such information.

The list of manufacturer(s) sources is a rating component of this Invitation for Bid to provide information on the company producing the product. Kindly provide as much information as possible about all company(ies) involved on this project. Question 2. Do you have an actual sample bag (previous model or similar) available for inspection?

Question 3. What kind of material is the handle? Same material as the bag or a ribbon type?

Question 4. (Is the) Lamination or coating only outside? (Is the) Purpose of the lamination is for scratch protection or to preserve the image longer?

Question 5. What is the purpose of the small handle in the center? Is it like a button to close the bag? The small handle sewn with 'X' reimbursement as well (like the big handle)?

Question 6. The picture of the design looks very clean on the bag's edges, but all edges need stitched seams and the actual bag will not appear as clean image as the picture shown in the design.

Question 7. Manufacturing involves multiple of sources/factories, from raw materials to finishing. How many sources do we have to submit?
