**GVB RESPONSE:** Section 1.11 relates to abiding by the regulations and laws of Guam as it pertains to doing business on Guam; however, this RFP does not require the actual work to be done on Guam. Please submit any documentation or statement that will provide proof or legitimacy of your business. Any documentation proving there are no legal issues is permissible. 
