QUESTION 1:

In the "Statement of Purpose," the RFP reads: The Guam Visitors Bureau "GVB", a non-stock, non-profit membership corporation, seeks to retain the services of an established and qualified professional research services ("Firm") with specialties in the Japan market for the purpose of assisting GVB in studying Japanese visitor attitudes toward Guam as a leisure destination on a quantitative and qualitative basis.
