





### PAYING IT FORWARD – CUSTOM CONTINUES TO HELP THOSE IN NEED

Håfa adai! Harkening back through the millennia, social reciprocation remains a fundamental tenet of island life. In the CHamoru culture we call it *kustumbren chenchule'* (the custom of perpetually returning favors at appropriate times).

It means we dig deep for those in need, with the mutual understanding that they will assist us whenever we could use a hand up ourselves. And the greater the depth of trust and appreciation this cooperative relationship is built upon, the more we tend to give whatever we can afford.

This long-honored system of sustainable cohabitation can, does, and should apply on higher scales of business and governance, too.

With that in mind, the Guam Visitors Bureau thanks local lawmakers for taking special notice of the pressing list of village needs developed by the Mayors Council in cooperation with GVB. True to the ancient order of *chenchule'*, we are grateful for timely draft legislation introduced by Sens. Joe S. San Agustin and Amanda L. Shelton and supported by growing number of cosponsors in the 36<sup>th</sup> Guam Legislature. Bill No. 200-36 seeks to meet the checklist of costs specified by GVB management in written and spoken testimony delivered at the October hearings for this legislation.

# NEW GUAM TRAVEL GUIDANCE

Governor Lou Leon Guerrero announced at a recent press conference new entry protocols; took **effect November 20**

- Individuals traveling from a foreign country are subject to a 10-day quarantine at a government facility (*facility and services included therein are provided at no cost to travelers*) with the following exemptions:
  - Full vaccinated with FDA authorized or approved, or WHO-EUL approved COVID-19 vaccines; or
  - A valid negative PCR test result collected no more than three (3) days prior to DEPARTURE; or
  - A valid negative antigen test result collected no more than one (1) day prior to DEPARTURE, as provided in the Public Health Guidance.

# INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL POLICY

New policy requiring foreign nationals (non-U.S. citizens who are nonimmigrants) traveling to the US by air to be **fully vaccinated** against COVID-19 took effect **November 8**

- FDA approved and authorized vaccines, and vaccines that have an Emergency Use Listing (EUL) from the WHO are accepted for air travel (Janssen/J&J, Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Covishield, BIBP/Sinopharm, & Sinovac)
- Vaccinated inbound travelers, including US citizens, must also show proof of a negative COVID-19 test taken **no more than three days before departure** to travel to the US from abroad
  - Unvaccinated Americans abroad will need a negative COVID-19 test within a day of return flight
- CDC considers full vaccination possible with mixed doses, so long as they are approved either by the FDA or WHO
- Limited exemptions are given for unvaccinated (click link for complete exemption list)

# TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS BY MARKET

## JAPAN

- The Japanese government does not distinguish between vaccinated and unvaccinated travelers for entry requirements
- All arrivals, regardless of nationality are subject to 10-day quarantine (except business traveler)
- Secure negative certificate 72 hours prior to departure; airline to verify; test again *upon arrival*
- Download 3 apps on smartphone\* (MySOS, Google Maps and COCOA) \* *Traveler will be required to rent a smartphone if they do not own one*
- For Japanese nationals who have negative result in both tests, they are requested to 10-days self-quarantine at home
- Guam residents who has US passport holders are subject to 10-day quarantine, which is the the same restriction as for Japanese nationals
- The three-day quarantine scheme for vaccinated business travelers upon arrival went into effect on November 8
- Japanese government accepted the vaccination certificate issued in 82 countries and regions

## SOUTH KOREA

- All travelers to South Korea must provide proof of a negative PCR test result collected within 72 hours of their departure
- As of May 5, those fully vaccinated in South Korea can bypass quarantine; as of Aug 30, PCR test required on Day 1 and Day 6/7 of arrival
- Those not fully vaccinated in Korea must undergo 10-day home quarantine; PCR tests required on day 1 and day 12/13 of arrival
  - Those vaccinated overseas must undergo 10-day home quarantine; PCR tests required on day 1 and day 8/9 of arrival
- Korean nationals arriving without a negative PCR test will be required to undergo a 7-day quarantine at a government facility at their expense (\$120/day), followed by 7 days of home quarantine
  - Korean nationals arriving without a negative PCR test will be denied entry. If the test result submitted is found to be invalid after arrival, the traveler will undergo a 5-day quarantine at a government facility at their expense (\$120/day), followed by 5 days of home quarantine
- Foreigners arriving without a negative PCR test will be denied entry
- Children under the age of 6 may be exempted from the negative PCR test result requirement and quarantine if all of the accompanying persons traveling with children have vaccinated and submitted valid negative PCR test results
- Korean resident who receives their first dose in Korea and receives their second dose on Guam are able to bypass quarantine upon arrival in Korea if they register and get 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of vaccination certificate from the local public health center in Korea. (if no registration/issuance, no quarantine exemption)

# TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS BY MARKET

## TAIWAN

- Requires a negative PCR test 72 hours prior to departure
- Fill out electronic health declaration form prior to departure via Quarantine System for Entry @ <https://hdhq.mohw.gov.tw>
- Travelers are required to make an affidavit stating that the location of their intended **14-day** quarantine in Taiwan meets relevant regulations
- All travelers will be quarantined for 14 days with the following exceptions: Taiwan tourists who participate in the Palau Travel Corridor program only need 5 days enforcement self-health monitoring + 9 days self-health monitoring (individual is not allow to take any public transportations in this period)
- 7+7: those who have received the second dose of a COVID vaccine at least 14 days prior to arrival will be able to reduce their hotel or quarantine center stay to 7 days, while the remaining 7 days can then be spent at their place of residence.

## PHILIPPINES

- All nationals/Filipinos, including spouse and children (Filipino/ foreign), foreign crew members, foreign government and international organization officials accredited to the Philippines and foreign nationals allowed under relevant IATF resolutions are permitted entry to the Philippines

**Fully vaccinated, arriving from green country, NO QUARANTINE**

**All other arriving travelers from green or yellow country, 3 or 7-DAY QUARANTINE IN GOVERNMENT FACILITY, DEPENDING ON VAX STATUS**

- 10 days: \$1,000 USD
- 7 days: \$700 USD\*
- PCR test: \$70 USD

*Quarantine cost varies based on hotel; prices are estimates in the mid-range. GUAM is on yellow list.*



## NATIONWIDE

- The number of cases per 100,000 people in Japan for the past week was 0.86.
- New cases nationwide have been below 500 for 36 consecutive days since October 17.

## VACCINATION

- 96.4 million people (76.2%) are fully vaccinated and the vaccination rate is the highest among the G7 countries.
- The vaccination rate for people in their 30s and older has reached more than 70% to date.
- 91% of senior citizens were fully vaccinated.
- New cases in Hokkaido have a tendency to increase compared to other regions in Japan.
- Booster shots will be scheduled to start in December for health care workers and in January for senior citizen.

## TRAVEL

## S. KOREA TO CUT DOSAGE INTERVAL FOR BOOSTER SHOTS ON SENIOR CITIZENS



- South Korea will cut the dosage interval between initial vaccination booster shots on senior citizens amid the rising number of critically-ill virus patients.
- Booster shots for people aged 60 or older and nursing hospital patients can be administered four months after their last dose, while those in their 50s can get extra jabs five months after their primary COVID-19 vaccination.

## KOREA TO REVIEW LOCAL PRODUCTION OF NOVAVAX VACCINE

- Korea will review local drugmaker SK Bioscience's request to manufacture and sell Novavax COVID-19 vaccine here.
- The affiliate under SK Group had signed a deal with the U.S. vaccine producer Novavax for consignment production of the COVID-19 vaccine in 2020.



## SCHOOLS CAUTIOUSLY RESUME IN-PERSON CLASSES AMID SURGING INFECTIONS



- All kindergartens and schools across the country will return to full-scale in-person classes, despite the continuous surge in daily COVID-19 infections and the number of critically ill patients.
- Other face-to-face activities, such as club meetings and field trips, will be expanded gradually depending on the virus situation.

## GERMANY TO LIMIT PUBLIC LIFE AMID SURGING INFECTION RATES



- Germany will limit large parts of public life in areas where hospitals are becoming dangerously full of COVID-19 patients to those who have either been vaccinated or have recovered from the illness.
- The government would also consider a request for legislation to require that care and hospital workers be vaccinated.



## CANADA TO DROP PCR COVID-19 TEST FOR SOME RETURNING TRAVELERS

- Canada is no longer obliging Canadian travelers returning from short foreign trips to take expensive molecular COVID-19 tests upon the complaints from travel industry.
- The requirement was decried as a major impediment by business and travelers on both sides of the U.S.-Canada border because it deterred short trips by cross-border day trippers.

## U.S. EXPANDS COVID-19 BOOSTER ELIGIBILITY TO ALL ADULTS



- U.S. regulators expanded eligibility for booster shots of COVID-19 vaccines to all adult amid a recent rise in infections.
- The U.S. FDA broadened its authorization of booster doses to all adults who had received their second shot of either the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine at least six months prior.

## KOREA'S THIRD TRAVEL BUBBLE AGREEMENT WITH PALAU



- The Korean government agreed with Palau to implement the Travel Bubble agreement in stages, the specific guidelines of implementation to be finalized after the quarantine authorities of both countries discuss details.
- The background of the Travel Bubble Agreement is that Palau's vaccination rate exceeded 92 percent and the vaccination eligibility will be expanded to children aged 5 or older.







# TAIWAN



## REGISTRATION FOR MIX-AND-MATCH VACCINE APPROACH TO OPEN THURSDAY

On November 3, CECC announced that it will temporarily suspend its use of the key high-risk country list that includes countries mainly because of the Delta variant, and that the quarantine measures applicable to arrivals from areas under Level 3 travel notice will apply to arrivals from India, the UK, and Myanmar starting on November 6.


The latest list of the risk categories for countries/regions is as follows:

- Level 1 (Watch): None
- Level 2 (Alert): Palau
- Level 3 (Warning): The rest of the countries/regions in the world except for Palau

CECC announced foreign workers will be allowed to enter Taiwan under a Ministry of Labor program provided that related pandemic prevention measures should be followed.

- People other than medical workers will soon have the option of being vaccinated against COVID-19 using different vaccine brands for the first time since Taiwan's vaccine rollout began in late March.
- Registration for the mix-and-match approach will be open on the government's 1922 vaccination website from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Thursday, Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) spokesperson Chuang Jen-hsiang said at a press briefing Wednesday.
- The roughly 2.25 million people who have received one dose of the AstraZeneca vaccine and have not yet gotten a second dose will be able to register their willingness to get a Moderna or Pfizer-BioNTech jab, Chuang said.
- Registering a preference does not commit an individual to the mix-and-match approach but will give people that option when the CECC opens slots for appointments in the future, he said.

- In response to influx of inbound travelers before Lunar New Year holiday, CECC adjusted quarantine measures.
- On November 11, CECC announced the "7+7" policy for travelers who have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19 for at least two weeks before their arrival in Taiwan.
- Under the policy, which will be in place from Dec. 14, 2021 to Feb. 14, 2022, travelers will spend the first seven days of quarantine in a government facility or designated hotel, and then spend the remaining seven days of quarantine at home.

## TAIWAN TO LET IN 5,000 FOREIGN MANDARIN STUDENTS IN 2022

- The Ministry of Education (MOE) on Wednesday (Nov. 17) announced that it plans to allow 5,000 foreign non-scholarship, non-degree students to enter Taiwan in March next year to study Mandarin.
- During a press conference at the MOE on Wednesday, Minister of Education Pan Wen-chung (潘文忠) said that 13,000 foreign students with scholarships to study Mandarin have arrived in Taiwan for the 2021 academic year. Pan said that an additional 5,000 foreign students who had not received scholarships have applied to study Mandarin in Taiwan, but have not yet received approval.
- When asked by the media about the status of foreign Mandarin students, Pan said that 14,000 foreign students with scholarships to study Mandarin have applied since August, and of these, all but 1,000 have received approval for entry into Taiwan.
- Pan said the MOE will submit a plan to the Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) that would allow non-scholarship, non-degree students to enter the country.



## BOOKINGS FOR QUARANTINE CENTERS UNDER TAIWAN'S '7+7' PLAN START WEDNESDAY

The Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) on Monday (Nov. 15) announced that bookings for quarantine centers under the "7 plus 7" quarantine scheme will begin on Wednesday morning (Nov. 17).



Under the new program, those who have received the second dose of a COVID vaccine at least 14 days prior to arrival will be able to reduce their hotel or quarantine center stay to seven days during the holiday, while the remaining seven days can then be spent at their place of residence. CECC Spokesman Chuang Jen-Hsiang on Monday announced that reservations for quarantine center rooms for the shortened quarantine start at 10 a.m. Wednesday.

In anticipation of a massive influx of overseas Taiwanese returning for the Lunar New Year holiday, the new "7 plus 7" measures will be in effect from Dec. 14 to Feb. 14. During this period, quarantine centers will charge residents of Taiwan a rate of NT\$1,500 per day, about half the cost of rooms in epidemic prevention hotels.

According to Chuang, 21,600 rooms will be made available at quarantine centers for the shortened quarantine period. He pointed out that because accommodations in quarantine centers are allocated based on the number of rooms reserved per day and centers available, it is not possible to specify a location preference.

## TAIWAN TO DISCUSS GUARANTEEING ONE MRNA VACCINE DOSE FOR ALL

- Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) Spokesperson Chuang Jen-hsiang said the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) will discuss the possibility of ensuring every Taiwanese has received at least one mRNA vaccine dose.
- This was in response to a report mentioned during the CECC's routine press conference Monday (Nov. 15) that certain physicians believe everyone should get at least one dose of an mRNA vaccine to ensure better protection. He emphasized that Taiwan has ordered an additional 35 million Moderna doses for 2022 and 2023. Therefore, there should soon be an abundance of mRNA shots in stock.
- The CECC's plan to allow mixing and matching of different COVID-19 vaccine brands starting this month remains unchanged, Chuang said at the press conference. Information regarding the 15th round of vaccinations will be made available as soon as Tuesday (Nov. 16), and online mixed-vaccine registrations will open once the platform is ready.
- Chuang said that since other countries have been administering third doses six to eight months after the second dose, currently very few people are eligible in Taiwan.
- The CECC's goal is to finish administering second doses by the end of the year, and it will begin discussing arrangements for third doses afterward as needed.



## TAIWAN'S MEDIGEN CAN NOW BE MIXED WITH AZ, BNT, OR MODERNA

- The Central Epidemic Command Center on Friday (Nov. 12) announced that individuals inoculated with Taiwan's Medigen COVID vaccine who need to fly overseas can mix their vaccination with foreign brands approved by Taiwan's Food and Drug Administration (FDA) to meet the COVID travel requirements of other countries.
- Health Minister and CECC head Chen Shih-chung said whether they have received one or two doses of Medigen, people preparing to travel can also take two doses of AstraZeneca (AZ), Pfizer-BioNTech (BNT), or Moderna starting 28 days after their last Medigen dose. Chen said the decision to allow the mixing of Medigen with the other vaccines was made after a discussion was held by experts during a meeting of the Ministry of Health and Welfare's Advisory Committee for Immunization Practices (ACIP).
- The policy change is designed for travelers who must submit a vaccine certificate that shows proof of vaccination with internationally recognized jabs. The CECC will now allow Medigen recipients preparing to travel overseas to be inoculated with vaccines that have received emergency use authorization (EUA) from Taiwan's FDA.

# PHILIPPINES

## QUARANTINE FOR VACCINATED TRAVELERS FROM YELLOW LIST AREAS SHORTENED

The Philippines shortened the quarantine period from 5 days to 3 days for travelers from "yellow list" territories who are fully vaccinated against COVID-19. Effective Nov. 22, fully vaccinated individuals from yellow list areas will be required to present a negative RT-PCR test conducted 72 hours prior to their departure from origin, said acting Palace spokesman Cabinet Secretary Karlo Nograles. Upon arrival, they shall undergo a 3-day facility-based quarantine. They will be tested for COVID-19 on the third day, with the date of arrival considered the first day, Nograles said in a press briefing.

He said they may be discharged from facility quarantine upon release of a negative RT-PCR test. Afterwards, they will be enjoined to self-monitor up to the 14th day from arrival, he added. "This latest development will greatly contribute to the on-going recovery of the tourism sector this holiday season while also providing more time to those who want to return home to be with their loved ones in the Philippines," Tourism Secretary Bernadette Romulo-Puyat said in a statement.

Nograles said fully vaccinated individuals from yellow list areas without a negative pre-departure test shall be required to undergo facility quarantine with a 5th day RT-PCR test.

Upon the release of a negative RT-PCR test, they may be discharged from facility quarantine. After which, they shall be required to undergo home quarantine until the 10th day from the date of arrival, he said.

Nograles said individuals who are unvaccinated, partially vaccinated, or whose vaccination status cannot be independently validated are to undergo facility-based quarantine with an RT-PCR test done on the 7th day. Upon release of a negative RT-PCR test, individuals shall be required to undergo home quarantine until the 14th day from the date of arrival, he said.

## EMERGENCY USE OF NOVAVAX VACCINE APPROVED

The Philippines has approved the emergency use of a COVID-19 vaccine by Novavax Inc (NVAX.O), the ninth vaccine approved in the Southeast Asian country. The nanoparticle vaccine, under the brand name Covovax, will be manufactured by Serum Institute of India, and is approved for use on adults 18 and above.

Covovax, which had efficacy of 89.7% in clinical trials, will be administered in two doses not less than 21 days apart. Early this month, Novavax received its first emergency use authorization from Indonesia. Novavax also filed an application for approval of the vaccine in Canada and with the European Medicines Agency.



## COVID-19 BOOSTER SHOTS BEGIN FOR SENIORS, PERSONS WITH COMORBIDITIES

The Philippines on Monday started giving booster shots to senior citizens and immunocompromised individuals, or those belonging to A2 and A3 categories, respectively, to allow more Filipinos to get additional protection against COVID-19.

During the ceremonial booster vaccination for the A2 category held at the East Avenue Medical Center (EAMC) in Quezon City, vaccine czar Carlito Galvez Jr. said many senior citizens were anticipating and registered for this program.

Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) chairman Benhur Abalos said that in the National Capital Region, there are 953,212 or 95% elderlies who are fully vaccinated while 857,092 or 98% got their first dose.

Galvez said the country has “enough doses of various brands” of COVID-19 vaccines to cover the booster shots for those belonging in the two categories. He said some 6 to 8 million doses have been allocated for the booster shots. This does not include the 1.6 million allocated for the additional doses for frontline healthcare workers.



Health Undersecretary Maria Rosario Vergeire said the booster shots are given when immunity is starting to wane after several months since receiving the vaccine while additional doses, or the third doses, are given to individuals who cannot mount the appropriate immunity against the sickness.

According to health experts, the senior citizens are not immunocompromised so they will get booster doses instead of third doses.

Immunocompromised individuals who are eligible to receive the additional vaccine dose include those with immunodeficiency state, people living with HIV, active cancer or malignancy, transplant patients, and patients under immunosuppressive treatments.

## DAILY COVID-19 CASES MAY DROP TO 500 BY YEAR-END IF TRENDS CONTINUE

New COVID-19 cases nationwide may drop to about 500 a day by year-end, but only with continued efforts to sustain the current case trends, according to a member of the OCTA Research group. According to professor Guido David, the country could see less than 1,000 cases by the first week of December, assuming the decline in numbers continues.

Guido also said while the latest single-day tally reached over 2,000 again for the first time in 11 days, it's not yet a cause for alarm. It's possible that the increase is simply due to backlog, because sometimes there is a massive reporting backlog, meaning these are old cases that have just been reported or encoded in the database. However, he added that the possibility of a spike in infections can't be discounted.

Citing the ongoing surge in cases in Europe and the waning efficacy of some vaccines, Guido reiterated the need to continue observing minimum health standards. He also stressed the importance of getting vaccinated and ensuring children's compliance with health protocols, noting that those infected in Europe and other countries are mostly the unvaccinated and minors.

## PHILIPPINES TO REOPEN 'SOON' TO VACCINATED FOREIGN TOURISTS

The Philippines has approved a plan to allow entry soon to foreign tourists vaccinated against COVID-19, following moves by other Southeast Asian countries to relax travel curbs. The coronavirus task force approved in principle the entry of fully vaccinated tourists from countries with low COVID-19 cases, but added that guidelines must be finalized.

The Philippines saw an 83% drop in foreign arrivals last year, receiving nearly 1.4 million visitors, compared to nearly 8.2 million in 2019. Japan, South Korea and China are its biggest tourism markets. The Philippines imposed some of Asia's tightest entry requirements during the pandemic and has been one of the region's worst hit countries in terms of cases, deaths and economic losses. Just over a quarter of its population has been vaccinated.
