DPHSS Guidance Memorandum 2020-08

RE: Additional Businesses Authorized to Operate during PCOR2

This document supplements DPHSS Guidance Memoranda 2020-01, 2020-02, 2020-05, and 2020-07 that were issued by the Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services on March 19, 2020; March 28, 2020; April 8, 2020; and May 07, 2020, respectively. The purpose of this guidance document is to list additional businesses that have been authorized to operate during Pandemic Condition of Readiness Level 2 (PCOR 2), which was declared by *Maga'hagan Guåhan* Lourdes A. Leon Guerrero on May 10, 2020.

APPROVED FOR OPERATION DURING PCOR 2:

1. All business operations and business activities during PCOR 1.
2. Businesses Approved for Operation at PCOR 2 Declaration (DPHSS Guidance Memorandum 2020-07).
3. Additional businesses authorized to operate during Pandemic Condition of Readiness Level 2 (PCOR2) beginning on Sunday, May 17, 2020 at 8:00am:
 - a. Outdoor, non-contact activities limited to:
 - i. Golfing (to include opening of golf courses);
 - ii. Tennis (to include the opening of outdoor tennis courts); and
 - iii. Scuba Diving (to include the opening of dive shop services).
 - b. Animal grooming.

The above businesses and organizations under Item 3 may proceed to operate after industry-specific plans are developed and submitted with COVID-19 prevention and control measures outlined in the document, *Minimum Pandemic Workplace Operational Requirements*, which was issued by the Department of Public Health and Social Services.
