WHAT IS THE WTTC SAFE TRAVELS STAMP?

The World Travel & Tourism Council (WTTC) created the first ever global safety and hygiene stamp. This stamp enables travelers to recognize destinations around the world that have adopted standardized health and hygiene protocols.

Guam Visitors Bureau (GVB) serves as the official organization to advocate for the implementation of these protocols in Guam and to issue the Guam Safe certification and Safe Travels stamp to local businesses.

JAPAN

- The state of emergency has been extended to June 20 for certain prefectures.
- Emergency declaration in effect nationwide
- Local government began inoculating people with underlying conditions in June and 65 or older
- Large-scale vaccination sites opened in Tokyo and Osaka with support from self-defense forces; similar venues opened in Miyagi, Gunma, Aichi and other many local areas
- Japan has strengthened its border measures for arrivals after variants were detected
- Japan will start COVID-19 vaccinations at workplaces and universities
- JAL announced its "JAL Corona Cover" will be extended to end of Sept 2021

PHILIPPINES

- Duterte to donate \$1m to COVAX facility as the WHO-led program has helped the country a lot in its vaccination drive
- Department of Health says it is not yet the time to drop the face shield policy
- The Philippines expects to receive 2.2 million doses of Pfizer vaccine
- COVID-19 vaccine delivery schedule is shown in appendix
- GVB is reaching out to U.S. expats and green card holders residing in the Philippines to get vaccinated in Guam

SOUTH KOREA

- Daily caseloads have been going up and down with no significant signs of a letup as cluster infections continue to be reported nationwide
- 887K AstraZeneca vaccines arrived in Korea
- Government social distancing measures, ends on June 13
- Korean tourists can enter the Czech Republic freely without restrictions
- Only people over 60 years old in South Korea will be able to make pre-reservations to receive leftover COVID-19 vaccines
- The military was to begin administering Pfizer's coronavirus vaccine to soldiers under 30 years old
- The U.S. White House has announced plans to share 80 million doses globally by the end of June, most through COVAX.
- Korea likely to open overseas travel packages to Guam; air carriers are planning to resume international operation this summer
- June outbound seat capacity is 945 seats

TAIWAN

- Nationwide Level 3 COVID-19 alert will be extended to June 28, as the recent domestic outbreak has shown no signs of easing
- People who get vaccine jabs under the government-subsidized vaccine program will no longer have to pay administrative surcharges
- United States' pledge to donate 750,000 COVID-19 vaccines to Taiwan has sent a strong and clear message of its support; Taiwan government is grateful




HIGHLIGHT NATIONWIDE

- The government has extended the state of emergency to June 20 for Tokyo, Hokkaido, Aichi, Kyoto, Osaka, Hyogo, Okayama, Hiroshima, Fukuoka, and Okinawa
- Pre-emergency measures:
 - ▶ **Until June 20:** Chiba, Saitama, Kanagawa, Gifu, and Mie
 - ▶ **Until June 13:** Gunma, Ishikawa and Kumamoto
- The new cases in Tokyo have declined for the 24th consecutive day.
- Emergency declaration in effect nationwide.
- Possibly lifting the restrictions on Gunma, Ishikawa and Kumamoto on June 13.

EXTENSION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY

- Establishments that only serve alcohol are requested to remain closed.
- Venues and Karaoke shops are still banned from serving alcohol at all time.
- Restaurants and bars serving food and beverages must continue to close by 8PM.
- Department stores, movie theaters and other commercial facilities will be close by 8PM.
- A capacity of 5,000 spectators or 50 percent of venue capacity will stay in effect for sports events and must conclude by 9PM.
- The people there will be asked to stay home and avoid all nonessential outings.
- Businesses are being encouraged to have employees work from home to reduce the number of commuters by 70%.



JAPAN COVID-19 NEWS

HIGHLIGHT

- The number vaccination has exceeded 15,6 million nationwide.
- 3.3 million medical workers and 649,000 older people have received their second shots. (as of June 3)
- Local government begin inoculating people with underlying conditions in June and all people aged 65 or older will be fully vaccinated by the end of July.
- The large-scale vaccination sites opened on May 24 in Tokyo and Osaka with support from self-defense force. Daily capacity is 10,000 shots and 5,000 shots, respectively.
- The similar venues had opened in Miyagi, Gunma, Aichi and other many local area.
- Tokyo Government will begin operating a large-scale vaccination center at the former site of Tsukiji.
- The five additional venues will be created in areas including the Tama region in western Tokyo.

COVID-19 VACCINATION UPDATE



BORDER CONTROL MEASURES

- Japan has strengthened its border measures for arrivals after coronavirus variants were detected in the country.
- Japanese citizens and residents with valid documents can re-enter Japan.
- Stopped issuing most types of visas.
- Submit proof of a negative result from a Covid-19 test taken within 72 hours before their departure for Japan.
- 14days quarantine after entering Japan.
- Daily reporting location and health status.
- No usage of public transport.
- There are **three 14-day quarantine rules** for incoming traveler including Japanese.
- Arrivals from total 42 countries and regions where variants have been reported are requested to stay for **3 or 10 days** at specific facilities designated by government.

JAPAN COVID-19 NEWS

HIGHLIGHT

- Japan will start COVID-19 vaccinations at workplaces and universities on June 21 to speed up the pace of the country.
- The two-dose vaccine developed by U.S. biotech firm Moderna Inc. will be used.
- Firms and universities will determine who will be inoculated, adding that family members of employees are likely to be eligible.
- Workers and students will be able to get vaccinations even before they receive vaccination tickets from municipalities.
- There is no age limit as long as you are at least 18 years old and over.
- Major companies such as Panasonic and JTB have decided to inoculate their employees from June 21.
- Fujitsu, Sony Group, Toyota Motor Corporation, Softbank Group, Rakuten Group, etc., are planning to participate in this project.

VACCINE UPDATE

VACCINATION CERTIFICATE

JAPAN GOVERNMENT

- The government has planned to issue vaccine certificates and passports to prove the vaccination history of the new coronavirus vaccine as early as this summer.

PURPOSE

- Vaccine passports are issued to overseas travelers, mainly for business traffic.

PRE-NEGOTIATION WITH OTHER COUNTRIES

- Japanese nationals can be exempted from quarantine after entry into the other country?
- Under what conditions will Japan accept vaccine passport holders from other countries?

BACKGROUND

- Japan has adopted a long-term strategy to catch up with the development and production of vaccines in US and Europe and strengthen its ability to develop vaccines domestically.

INITIATIVES BY JAPAN DOMESTIC PHARMACEUTICAL MANUFACTURERS

- Takeda Pharmaceutical Company Limited has been conducting clinical trials since February for a recombinant protein vaccine developed by Novavax in the U.S.
- AnGes is conducting clinical trials for a DNA vaccine.
- Shionogi & Co. is conducting clinical trials for a recombinant protein vaccine.
- Daiichi Sankyo Co. and KM Biologics Co. have started clinical trials for vaccines, marking the third and fourth times





- The positive rate for two weeks is below 1%.

KOREANS CAN ENTER THE CZECH REPUBLIC WITHOUT ANY RESTRICTIONS FROM JUNE 1

- From June 1, Korean tourists can enter the Czech Republic freely without restrictions.
- South Korea is currently classified as a low-risk country, and the Czech Republic has opened its borders to allow Koreans to enter the country for travel purposes.
- Koreans do not need to issue a visa, submit a negative PCR test result or go through a quarantine period when entering the country.



HEALTH AUTHORITIES TO PRIORITIZE AGED OVER 60 TO GET LEFTOVER VACCINE

- Only people over 60 years old in South Korea will be able to make pre-reservations to receive leftover COVID-19 vaccines from June 4.
- Until now, younger people were able to get left-over AstraZeneca vaccines at a nearby hospitals.
- However, South Korea's health authorities are imposing this new age limit prioritizing inoculations for the over 60s only.



US TO SWIFTLY BOOST GLOBAL VACCINE SHARING

- The White House has announced plans to share **80 million doses globally by the end of June**, most through COVAX.
- Of the first 19 million donated through COVAX, approximately 6 million doses will go to South and Central America, 7 million to Asia and 5 million to Africa.



MILITARY TO BEGIN VACCINATION CAMPAIGN FOR MILITARY UNDER 30

- The military was to begin administering Pfizer's coronavirus vaccine to soldiers under 30 years old on June 7.
- Of around 414,000 eligible service members, those who applied for the inoculation will be given the vaccine.
- Soldiers aged 30 and older were already given AstraZeneca's COVID-19 vaccine, with about 88 percent, or 116,900 members, of the age group agreeing to take their first shots.



CHINA'S SINOVAC VACCINE GETS WHO EMERGENCY APPROVAL

- The World Health Organization has approved China's Sinovac COVID-19 vaccine for emergency use.
- It is the second Chinese vaccine to receive the green light from the WHO, after Sinopharm.

KOREA LIKELY TO OPEN OVERSEAS TRAVEL PACKAGES TO GUAM

- Travel agencies expect Guam, Hawaii, Switzerland, Maldives and Taiwan to take the lead in initial overseas destinations since the outbreak of the COVID-19.
- Guam is a destination that will lead the recovery of the market as it has many positive factors such as relatively close distance, a small number of confirmed case, solid infrastructure, etc. but there are some issues to be cleared.

TAIWAN EXTENDS NATIONAL LEVEL 3 COVID-19 ALERT

Taiwan's nationwide Level 3 COVID-19 alert will be extended to June 28, as the recent domestic outbreak has shown no signs of easing, the Cabinet announced Monday.

Under the Level 3 alert, all schools in the country will remain closed until the current semester ends in early July. People will still be required to wear masks at all times when they leave their homes, and a ban will be retained on indoor gatherings of more than four people and outdoor gatherings of more than nine people.

The Level 3 alert, the second highest in Taiwan's four-tier COVID-19 alert scale, was first issued in Taipei and New Taipei on May 15.

It was implemented nationwide on May 19 and was initially scheduled to end on May 28, but on May 25, it was extended to June 14.



COVID-19 VACCINE ROLLOUT TO BE COMPLETELY FREE

People who get vaccine jabs under the government-subsidized vaccine program will no longer have to pay administrative surcharges such as registration fees starting Monday, according to the Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC).

At present, those who receive vaccine jabs under the government program do not have to pay for the vaccine but have to pay up to NT\$300 (NT\$10.73) in administrative fees.

The CECC said on Saturday that the fee will now be covered by a NT\$4 billion budget, under a broader relief budget that was approved at a Cabinet meeting last week.

More funding will also be allocated to help local governments establish stations where large numbers of vaccine shots can be administered, the CECC said.

U.S.' VACCINE DONATION A SIGN OF STRONG SUPPORT FOR TAIWAN: MOFA

- The United States' pledge to donate 750,000 COVID-19 vaccines to Taiwan has sent a strong and clear message of its support for the country, and the government is grateful for that, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) said Sunday.
- The specific size of the pledge was confirmed during a brief visit to Taiwan by American senators Tammy Duckworth, Dan Sullivan and Christopher Coons on Sunday morning, and is part of Washington's plan to share at least 80 million vaccine doses globally.



TAIWAN THANKS WASHINGTON FOR COVID-19 VACCINE PLEDGE (UPDATE)

- President Tsai is grateful that the United States will send 7 million COVID-19 vaccine doses to Taiwan and other Asian countries, especially at a time when Taiwan is facing its worst outbreak, Presidential Office spokesperson Xavier said Friday (6/4).
- Chang said President Tsai thanked all of Taiwan's diplomats and others who have tried their best to secure vaccines for Taiwan, and she also thanked Americans across party lines for their support.
- Tsai said she hoped Taiwan and the U.S. will continue cooperation efforts and jointly contribute to promoting global epidemic control and health care, and the world's welfare.

DUTERTE SAYS PHILIPPINES TO DONATE \$1M TO COVAX FACILITY

The Philippines committed to donating \$1 million, or around P50 million, to the COVAX global vaccine sharing initiative, which seeks to boost COVID-19 inoculation programs in lower-income countries, President Rodrigo Duterte said. Duterte said the World Health Organization-led program has helped the country “a lot” in its vaccination drive.


“I will contribute because COVAX has been good to us. At the time we needed it most, [it was] one of the earliest agencies to help us aside from the contributions made by China,” the president said.



The Philippines has so far received over 2.5 million doses of AstraZeneca and 193,050 doses of Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccines from the COVAX facility.

DOH: NOT YET TIME TO DROP FACE SHIELDS



The Department of Health said it is not yet the time to ditch the policy requiring Filipinos to wear face shields in public places due to the low inoculation coverage in the country. Health Secretary Francisco Duque III said this as a response to the appeal of Manila Mayor Isko Moreno to stop requiring the use of face shields outdoors. “We can’t remove the face shield policy for now when our two-dose vaccination coverage is still low due to inadequate vaccine supply,” Duque said.

2.2 MILLION PFIZER DOSES SET TO ARRIVE JUNE 11

The Philippines expects to receive 2.2 million doses of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine on June 11, vaccine czar Carlito Galvez Jr. announced.

This will be the biggest shipment of Pfizer doses to arrive in the country after over 193,000 doses were delivered on May 10. The Pfizer vaccine is the second most preferred COVID-19 vaccine brand, according to a Social Weather Stations survey.

President Duterte has ordered that the Pfizer vaccines given by the COVAX facility be administered only to indigent Filipinos, or those in the A5 vaccine priority group. But Galvez clarified that the upcoming Pfizer delivery will still go to health workers, elderly, and persons with comorbidities as there are still many in these groups who have not yet been vaccinated.

The government claims this is in keeping with the World Health Organization (WHO) requirement that COVAX facility vaccines go to vulnerable groups.


