SOUTH KOREA

MIDDLE EAST TENSIONS RAISE ALARMS IN TRAVEL INDUSTRY AHEAD OF SUMMER PEAK



Rising tensions between Israel and Iran are causing market disruptions ahead of Korea's summer travel peak, heightening concerns over fuel prices, currency fluctuations, and consumer demand.

Since June 13, 2025, escalating conflict between the two nations has driven up oil prices, weakened the Korean won, and led to declines in travel and airline stocks. While the immediate impact is contained, a prolonged or intensified situation could increase travel costs and discourage bookings during the critical summer season.

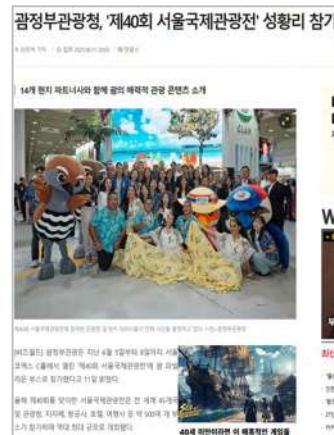

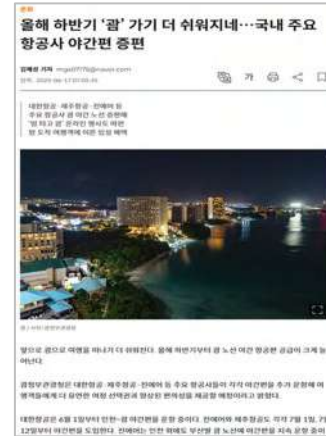

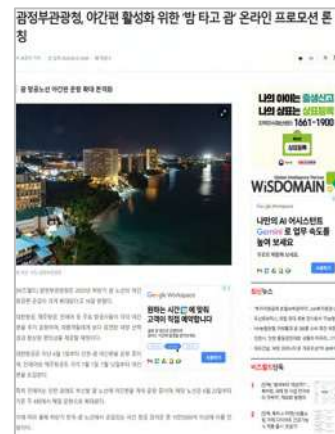

- United Airlines started the direct flight TPE-GUM service starting April 2nd.
- The limited-time promotion for TPE-GUM route has been extended from March 4 to September 26. The promotional fares are US\$304 (TWD 10,000, tax excluded). UA launched a new discounted economy K-class fare of US\$380. (TWD 12,500, tax excluded) for both B2B and B2C channels.



TAIWAN TRAVELERS GET FREE WAIVER FOR CHINA

China will waive application fees for first-time Taiwanese applicants of the Mainland Travel Permit from July 1 to December 31, 2025, aiming to boost cross-strait travel and people-to-people exchanges. The policy, led by China's Taiwan Affairs Office and other central agencies, removes fees of NT\$1,500-2,400, though optional home delivery charges (NT\$50-200) will still apply during the waiver period. Analysts interpret the move as a strategic effort to deepen grassroots ties and encourage greater travel, business, and cultural interaction between Taiwan and China during the six-month initiative.

TAOYUAN AIRPORT EXPECTS TRAVEL NUMBERS TO BEAT 2019

Passenger traffic at Taiwan Taoyuan International Airport is nearing pre-pandemic levels, with over 20 million travelers recorded by June 4, and 2024 figures expected to surpass 2019 due to travel recovery and long weekends. July and August passenger volume is projected to rise 9.5% year-on-year, influenced by factors like economic shifts, exchange rates, travel habits, and global politics, including airspace changes due to Middle East tensions.

PHILIPPINES ANNOUNCES DIGITAL NOMAD VISA

The Philippines is preparing to launch its official Digital Nomad Visa in June 2025, offering foreign remote workers the opportunity to reside in the country while working for employers or clients based abroad. This move aligns the Philippines with a broader global trend toward flexible, remote work and positions the country alongside other Southeast Asian economies that are actively attracting mobile professionals with tailored visa schemes. Valid for 12 months and renewable for an additional 12 months, the Digital Nomad Visa allows for a total two-year stay. Applications are expected to open in June 2025.



U.S. EMBASSY TO NONIMMIGRANT VISA APPLICANTS: SET SOCMED ACCOUNTS TO PUBLIC

The U.S. Embassy in the Philippines announced that all non-immigrant visa applicants are now required to set their social media accounts to public. The Embassy advised that this request applies to all individuals applying for an F, M, or J nonimmigrant visa. These types of visas are all used by individuals coming to the US for educational or cultural exchange purposes. Both F and M visas are for students, while exchange visitors use J visas. According to the Embassy, this request is to facilitate vetting necessary to establish their identity and admissibility to the United States.
