



TRAVEL TRADE UPDATE



"Travelers favor short-haul destinations during Golden Week"

During the May Golden Week, Korean travelers are prioritizing short-haul destinations, aiming for efficient travel that maximizes the limited time off. According to Incheon International Airport Corporation, approximately 1.48 million passengers are expected to travel through Incheon Airport between April 30 and May 6.

According to Jin Air's international flight booking data, Osaka ranks as the most favored destination during the golden week period follow by NHA Trang and Fukuoka. Other high-ranking destinations include Okinawa, Phu Quoc, and Guam, indicating continued strong demand for travel to Japan, Vietnam, and Guam.



- United Airlines started the direct flight TPE-GUM service starting April 2nd.

SOUTHERN TAIWAN CITY LAUNCHES INCLUSIVE TOURISM INITIATIVE

Kaohsiung's Tourism Bureau has certified 40 gender-friendly hotels and aims to double that number through a new art installation subsidy program supporting inclusive tourism. The first gender-friendly accommodation seminar drew 21 hospitality businesses, offering expert guidance on creating welcoming spaces for women, families, and LGBTQ+ travelers. New subsidies will support rainbow art, flags and gender-friendly restrooms, promoting inclusivity while enhancing the artistic quality of public hotel spaces.





TAIWAN'S EVA AIR PLANS DIRECT FLIGHTS TO DALLAS

EVA Air will launch direct flights between Taiwan Taoyuan International Airport and Dallas, Texas starting October 3, operating three flights per week and becoming the only Asian airline serving both Houston and Dallas. This route will market EVA Air's ninth destination in North America, expanding its already strong network of 90 weekly flights. The airline had previously operated cargo flights to Dallas since 1998. The new service is timed to optimize connections to Northeast and Southeast Asia, with early-morning arrivals in Taoyuan for seamless transit.

KLOOK'S TRAVEL PULSE STUDY INSIGHTS

A study by travel booking service firm Klook revealed that 98.5 percent of Filipinos are looking to travel domestically in 2025 while 56.3 percent said they plan to travel abroad.

The study surveyed about 500 Filipino respondents across the Philippines, mainly from Metro Manila and Cebu. Internationally, more Filipinos traveled to Vietnam, Taiwan, and Thailand in 2024 on top of the usual hotspots like Japan, South Korea, and Singapore.

The top consideration for 37.3 percent of the respondents when booking is perfect weather. All Filipino respondents agreed that travel is an effective way to manage stress and their well-being and consider it a form of therapy. The study also found that 78.4 percent use travel as a getaway for a mental health break with 31.6 percent of them choosing a nature retreat for a creative reset, higher than market average of 15.8 percent.

GVB LAUNCHES INCENTIVE PROGRAM

- Effective May 1, 2025
- GVB launched an incentive program designed to reward Philippine travel agencies for promoting group travel to Guam.
- Travel agencies who register for this program are eligible to earn up to USD \$20 per traveler.
- Flight dates must be between May 1-August 31, 2025
- Travelers must stay at a hotel or short-term rental.
