

KOREAN AIR NEARLY HALVES INTERNATIONAL FLIGHTS FROM REGIONAL AIRPORTS

Korean Air has significantly reduced its international flights from regional airports in 2024, operating 6,199 flights—a 45% drop from 11,408 in 2019. Busan's Gimhae Airport was among the hardest hit, with a 42% decline in flights, while the first quarter of 2025 also showed a 36% year-on-year decrease. The airline attributed the cuts to delays in aircraft deliveries, forcing a temporary scale-back in operations on certain routes.

However, the move has sparked criticism from civic groups and regional leaders, especially as flights at Incheon International Airport fell by only 5.7% during the same period. While demand on some routes, such as Busan-China, has yet to fully recover, concerns are growing that Korean Air is increasingly prioritizing long-haul routes and central hubs.



MANDATORY ELECTRONIC DECLARATION FORM

As of February 4, 2025, the Guam EDF is now MANDATORY upon entry into Guam. All persons arriving in Guam must comply with United States and Guam laws prior to their arrival. For your convenience, the form may be completed up to 72 hours prior to arrival date.
