

TRAVEL PROTOCOLS BY MARKET

JAPAN

NO QUARANTINE

- Traveler entering Japan from Guam will not be tested upon entry if they have received two times or more vaccinations.

REQUIREMENTS

- If you have been vaccinated 3 times of Covid-19 vaccine, you will be exempted from submitting a negative certificate when returning to Japan
- If NOT, negative result of COVID-19 test conducted within 72 hours prior to departure (RT-PCR, LAMP, TMA, TRC, Smart Amp, NEAR, Next Generation Sequence, CLEIA/ECLIA)
- Submit a written pledge that you will follow the Japanese authorities requirements and fill out questionnaires
- Install mobile application (MySOS, Google Maps, COCOA; travel insurance for COVID-19 related issues recommended

SOUTH KOREA

NO QUARANTINE

- All travelers entering South Korea are no longer subject to quarantine, regardless of vaccination status (as of June 8, 2022)

REQUIREMENTS

- All travelers entering South Korea must register their travel information on KDCA's Q-Code website: cov19ent.kdca.go.kr/cpassport
- Foreigners must apply for Korea Electronic Travel Authorization (K-ETA) if they do not already have it. K-ETA is valid for 2 years from the date of approval, or when the passport used to apply expires, whichever comes first.
- COVID-19 testing is no longer required before departure (as of September 3, 2022) and no longer required upon arrival (as of October 1, 2022)

TRAVEL PROTOCOLS BY MARKET

TAIWAN

Effective July 14, Taiwan is no longer requiring PCR negative test 2 days before their arrival flight for Taiwan nationals, ARC residents, and international transiting passengers.

Effective October 13, Taiwan to end quarantine, launch 'O+7' plan, raise weekly quota to 150,000, fully open borders, and end tour bans.

REQUIREMENTS

- Fill out electronic health declaration form prior to departure via Quarantine System for Entry @ <https://hdhq.mohw.gov.tw>.
- Those who enter Taiwan shall confirm quarantine program (book a quarantine hotel in advance; or if traveler plan to quarantine at home or a residence of their family or friends, should make sure the principle of one person per residence is met)

*CECC announced that Taiwan will loosen its current COVID-19 policies on **Nov. 7**, including some vaccine and rapid test requirements, canceling temperature check. Also starting **Nov. 7**, people participating in group tours and religious activities such as processions will no longer be required to take a COVID-19 rapid test and show proof of three shots of a vaccine against the disease, Wang said.*

Another revision will be for the protocols for close contacts of COVID-19 patients, he said, referring to the "3+4" policy that requires such contacts to conduct home isolation for three days and self-initiated disease prevention for another four days if they have not taken three shots of a COVID-19 vaccine.

*When the new measures take effect on **Nov. 7**, close contacts will only have to observe seven days of self-initiated epidemic prevention, Wang said, referring to it as a "O+7" policy.*

PHILIPPINES

NO QUARANTINE

- Fully vaccinated nationals / foreign nationals
- Children below 12 years who cannot be vaccinated shall follow quarantine protocols of the parent or accompanying adult/guardian

FACILITY-BASED QUARANTINE

- Unvaccinated, partially vaccinated, unverified nationals are subject to a facility-based quarantine until release of negative results (5th day swabbing); self-monitor until 14th day of arrival.

REQUIREMENTS

- All arriving passengers must register to One Health Pass portal within 48 hours prior to departure.
- Filipino and foreign nationals aged 18 and above who have received primary series of COVID-19 vaccine, and at least one (1) COVID-19 booster shot administered at any time prior to departure do NOT need a pre-departure COVID-19 test.
- If not boosted, a negative RT-PCR test taken within 48 hours or negative antigen test taken within 24 hours prior to departure from the country of origin is required.
- Self-monitor for any sign or symptom until the 7th day from arrival.
- Not applicable to children below 3 years old.









ENTRY PROTOCOLS

HIGHLIGHTS

- As of June 12, the submission of a negative PCR test certificate upon departure from Japan will no longer be required.
- Effective September 7, the 72-hour corona test required upon entry and return to Japan will be waived only if the patient has already been vaccinated three times.
- For those who have received two or fewer vaccinations, a PCR test (negative proof) within 72 hours prior to local departure is still required.
- Effective October 11, the daily entry limit has been eliminated.







DAILY CASE

KOREAN AIR RUNWAY OVERRUN ISSUE - OVERVIEW




MEDIGEN VACCINE RECIPIENTS CAN TRAVEL TO AT LEAST 10 COUNTRIES, AREAS: CECC

People who have received shots of the domestically-made Medigen vaccine can currently travel to at least 10 countries and areas that accept Medigen as proof of vaccination, without having to provide proof of a negative polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test, Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) head Victor Wang said Thursday.



The countries and areas that accept Medigen as proof of vaccination include Indonesia, Palau, New Zealand, Belize, Somaliland, Thailand, Estonia, Paraguay, Malaysia and Saint Kitts and Nevis, Wang said at a CECC press briefing.

However, Japan, one of the most popular destination among Taiwanese travelers, is not on the list.

In addition, as countries around the world have relaxed border controls, 14 currently do not require inbound travelers to provide proof of vaccination, including South Korea, which will resume visa-free entry privileges for travelers from Taiwan from Nov. 1, Wang pointed out.

SOUTH KOREA TO RESUME VISA-FREE ENTRY FOR TAIWAN NATIONALS

South Korea will fully restore visa-free entry privileges from Nov. 1 for travelers from eight countries and territories, including Taiwan, Japan, and Macau, on the basis of reciprocity, the country's health authorities said Wednesday.

The Korea Disease Prevention and Control Agency (KDCA) said at a press conference that the new rules had been introduced following consultations with the country's justice ministry and other relevant agencies.

Under the new rules, travelers from Taiwan, Japan, and Macau, as well as the Pacific Island nations of Solomon Islands, Kiribati, Micronesia, Samoa, and Tonga, will be allowed to enter Korea without a visa from Nov. 1, the KDCA said.

According to the Korea Tourism Organization's Taipei branch, however, travelers from Taiwan will still be required to apply online for a K-ETA travel authorization at least 72 hours before their departure.





TAIWAN REPORTS XBB, BQ.1.1 SUBVARIANTS FOR 1ST TIME



The Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) on Monday (Oct. 17) announced the first cases of the Omicron variants BQ.1.1 and XBB, while four BF.7 infections have also been confirmed.

At Monday's press briefing, Philip Lo, deputy head of the CECC's medical response division announced that 40 out of 41 local cases sequenced last week had the Omicron subvariant BA.5. Lo said 21 were in northern Taiwan, six in central Taiwan, and 12 in southern Taiwan.

As for 55 imported cases sequenced from last week, 76% were infected with BA.5, 10% had BA.2.75, 7% had BA.2, 5% had BA.4.6, and 2% had BF.7, while the first cases of BQ.1.1 and XBB were reported this week.

MULTIPLE CARRIERS TO RESUME FLIGHTS TO TAIWAN IN COMING MONTHS: CAA



Spurred by the easing of Taiwan's COVID-19 border controls, more than a dozen international airlines have said they plan to resume flights to the country by early next year, the Civil Aeronautics Administration (CAA) said Monday.

In a report to the Legislature, CAA chief Lin Kuo-shian said that in November and December, the weekly number of flights in and out of Taiwan is set to rise to 1,107, up 80 percent from October but still only two-fifths of 2019-level flight volume.

In terms of destinations, flights to and from Japan, which also recently lifted its border controls, will see the largest bump, rising from 104 to 312 per week, while flights to Southeast Asia will increase from 248 to 383.

Regarding international carriers, Lin noted that Air Macau, Thai Smile Air, AirAsia, and AirAsia X are scheduled to relaunch services to Taiwan in November or December.

CECC lowers COVID-19 travel notice for all countries/regions to Level 2: Alert, effective October 13, 2022; travelers should practice enhanced precautions

On October 12, the Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) announced that the COVID-19 travel notice for all countries/regions will be lowered to Level 2: Alert, effective 00:00 on October 13, 2022.

On September 29, CECC announced that, in response to the gradual relaxation of border restrictions, it will adjust the quarantine policy for arriving travelers.

Effective on October 13 (incoming flight's scheduled arrival time), arriving travelers will no longer be required to quarantine and will instead undergo a seven-day period of self-initiated prevention after arrival. Related border restrictions will also be lifted starting October 13.

Adjustment details are listed below.

1. Quarantine period: Quarantine will be ended, the day of arrival counts as Day 0. A seven-day period of self-initiated prevention will be required.
2. Rapid testing using at-home rapid test kits:
 - 4 rapid test kits will be given to all arriving passengers aged two and over.
 - Passengers take a rapid antigen test on the day of arrival or the first day of the self-initiated prevention period (D0/D1).
 - Arriving travelers should take a rapid test and produce a negative result within two days before going out during the self-initiated prevention period.
3. Arriving travelers will no longer be required to make a health declaration on the Quarantine System for Entry before arrival and to have a mobile phone with a Taiwanese number.

MARCOS DECLARES OCT. 31 AS NON-WORKING HOLIDAY

Office of the Press Secretary (OPS) officer-in-charge Undersecretary Cheloy Velicaria-Garafil announced that the President has already signed a proclamation declaring the holiday. Garafil said it aims to “give more time for families to be together” and to boost local tourism.

“The President has already signed the proclamation declaring October 31 as a special non-working holiday para na rin po mas marami po tayong time kasama ang ating pamilya at para ma-promote na rin ang ating local tourism (in order for us to have more time with our families and to promote local tourism),” she said.

The Palace official did not provide further explanation behind the President’s decision to declare the eve of All Saints’ Day as a special non-working holiday.



MIAA READY FOR INFLUX OF PASSENGERS IN COMING HOLIDAY SEASON

Manila International Airport Authority (MIAA) assured the public that it is prepared for the surge of passengers this coming holiday season. In the statement, MIAA said it has joined the Department of Transportation in its preparations for the yearly OPLAN Biyaheng Ayos for the coming Undas and Christmas holidays.

Among MIAA’s initiatives is to set up an Oplan help desk to assist passengers and will be the focal point for all inquiries on airport or airline concerns. Personnel from the Civil Aeronautics Board, meanwhile, will attend to issues about passenger rights. MIAA said it has also encouraged airline operators to appoint focal persons to attend to airline-related concerns and to work hand-in-hand with the duty representatives at the Oplan desk. The agency will also ensure the proper deployment of equipment and manpower resources to facilitate the handling of flights.

PAL PASSES TSA ASSESSMENT

Flag carrier Philippine Airlines (PAL) announced Thursday that it has passed the Transportation Security Administration's (TSA) quality control inspection, which included an assessment of its airport operations, passenger and baggage handling, and catering procedures.



The TSA is an agency of the United States Department of Homeland Security that has authority over the security of transportation systems within, and connecting to the United States.

PAL operates regular flights from Manila to the US destinations of Los Angeles, San Francisco, Honolulu, New York, and Guam.

"Our airline remains compliant with all requirements for our flights between Manila and the US, as with other routes. The men and women of our flag carrier shall continue to uphold the highest standards of safety and security to protect the flying public," said PAL president and chief operating officer Stanley Ng in a statement.

AIRASIA PH BACK TO PRE-PANDEMIC INT'L CAPACITY BY 2023

AirAsia Philippines is determined to achieve its pre-pandemic international capacity by second quarter of 2023 and surpass its records by the second half, CEO Ricky Isla announced Tuesday, October 18.

Already, "The demand for international travel is getting stronger every month as more countries relax their border protocols," he stated. "We plan on increasing our frequency to our current routes and grow our number of destinations before the year ends," Isla added.

As of the fourth quarter of 2022, Singapore and South Korea remain as AirAsia PH's top international destinations.

To sustain the momentum, the budget carrier is strengthening its partnership with transportation and tourism agencies present in its top routes.

Recently, the airline's top executives met with policymakers from Singapore and South Korea to reaffirm its commitment to drive larger foot traffic to these countries this fourth quarter.

eARRIVAL CARD to replace One Health Pass in PH

Attention: Passengers traveling to the Philippines

A new electronic ARRIVAL CARD (“eARRIVAL CARD”) has officially replaced the One Health Pass (OHP) as an entry requirement for arrival in the Philippines.

This new eARRIVAL CARD is easier to fill out and requires less information, in line with a decision by Philippine health authorities to simplify the arrival process.

To avoid long lines at the airport, we highly encourage you to fill out the eARRIVAL CARD within 72 hours prior to departure from your country of origin.

If you are unable to do so before departure, personnel from the Philippine Bureau of Quarantine (BOQ) and airport staff will assist you in completing and uploading the eARRIVAL CARD upon your arrival in the Philippines.

Other arrival protocols remain the same and follow Resolution 168 of the Philippine Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID).




