SOUTH KOREA





KOREAN AIR SIGNS US\$50 BILLION DEAL TO PURCHASE AIRCRAFT, ENGINES FROM BOEING

Korean Air Co. has signed a US\$50 billion agreement to purchase over 100 new planes and aircraft spare engines from Boeing Co. and GE Aerospace. The investment is a preemptive move to fuel growth ahead of its planned merger with Asiana Airlines and to bolster Korea-U.S. cooperation in the aerospace sector.

LCC OPERATORS PULL BACK ON MERGERS AND ACQUISITIONS

Korea's major LCCs are pulling back from acquisitions due to steep losses and tough competition. Jeju Air is unlikely to pursue Eastar Jet despite its fleet needs, and Sono Group is hesitant about Air Premia given T'way's deficit. Eastar Jet has rebounded under VIG partners and is expected to turn profitable this year, but the industry players are taking a cautious stance, prioritizing internal stability over costly M&A moves.

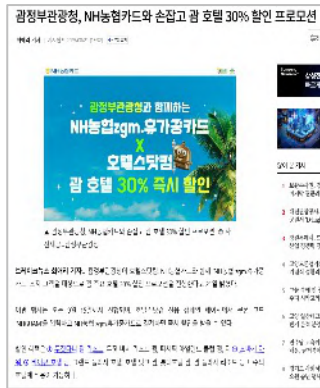

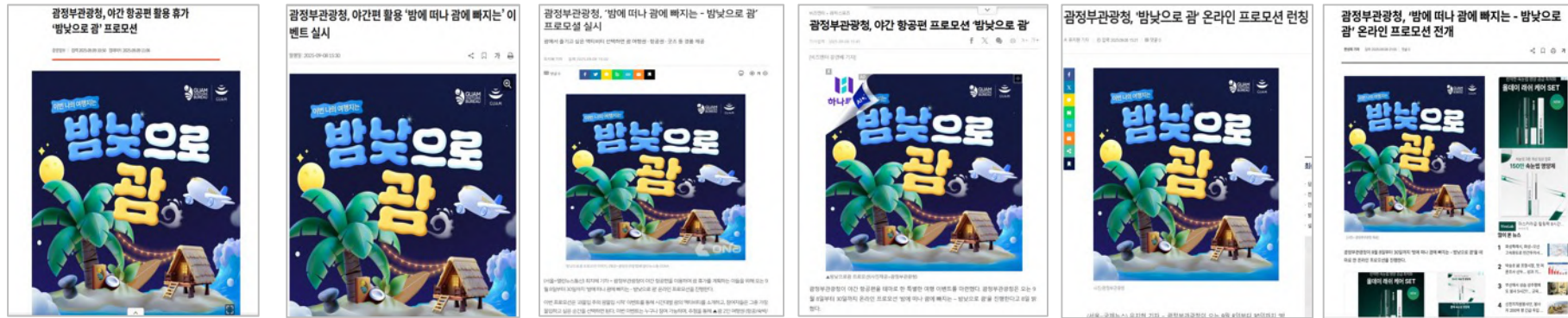

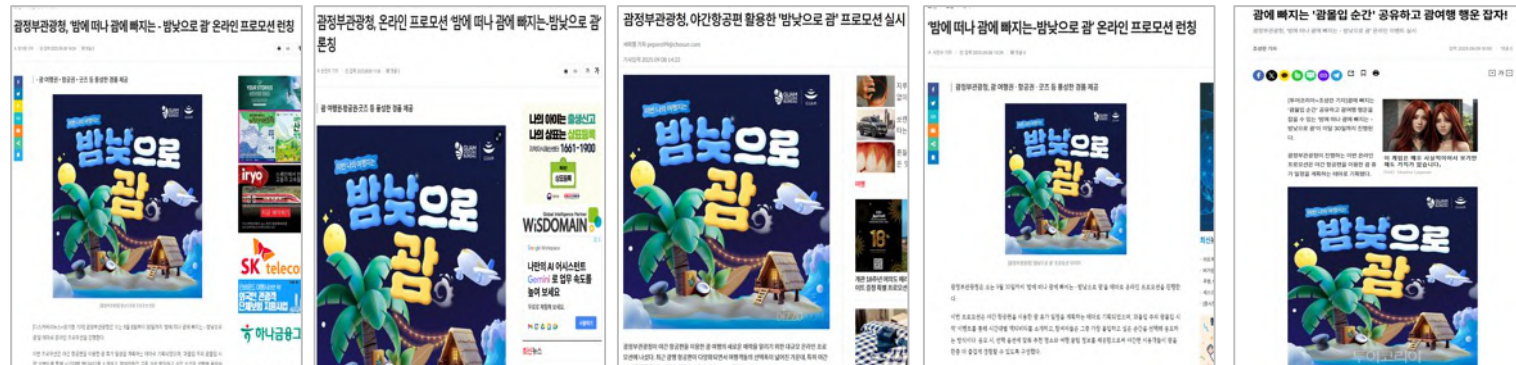

- The limited-time promotion for TPE-GUM route has been extended to September 26, 2025. The promotional fares are US\$304 (TWD 10,000, tax excluded) with a new discounted economy K-class fare of US\$380 (TWD 12,500, tax excluded) for both B2B and B2C channels.
- UA is offering a limited-time promotion for the TPE-GUM Wednesday departures. Promotional fares start at US\$276 (TWD 8,500, G-class, tax excluded) and US\$357 (TWD 11,000, K-class, tax excluded) valid for travel until Oct. 1, 2025 and ticketing by Sept. 1, 2025. Group fares for 10 or more passengers are available.

TAIWAN SEEKS TO MAKE MATSU A TOURIST DESTINATION

Tourism Administration head Chen Yu-hsiu said Matsu's preserved Cold War heritage, unique culture, and limited capacity make it better suited as a high-end international destination, rather than a mass domestic tourism spot, offering travelers exclusive and distinctive experiences. The ongoing Matsu Biennial, featuring over 200 artists from 49 countries, showcases the islands' cultural and historical identity, with installations like "Building a Nest" using wartime materials potentially becoming long-term landmarks to attract future travelers. Matsu can host about 220,000 visitors annually, but challenges remain in transport reliability, hospitality training, and industry mindset.



TAIWAN RAILWAY BOOSTS TAIPEI-TAICHUNG SERVICE WITH DAILY EMU3000 TRAINS

Taiwan Railway will run four trains - No. 127, 148, 193, and 194 - between Qidu and Changhua until December 31, strengthening connectivity along the Taipei-Taichung corridor with stops at major stations including Taipei and Taichung. The journey from Taipei to Taichung takes about two hours at NT\$500 (US\$16), offering a slower but cheaper alternative compared to the Taiwan High Speed Rail, which completes the route in one hour for NT\$700. Reservations open at midnight Tuesday and can be made through Taiwan Railway's website, mobile app, convenience store kiosks, or by phone, providing multiple booking options for passengers.

- Due to the United Airlines direct flight between TPE-GUM, they are considering establishing a partnership and study-tour program with Guam
- During the meeting, Principal Baker Ting expressed interest in signing an MOU with local schools in Guam for a sister-school partnership

- September 9, 2025
- GTO attended the Semicon Networking Summit to represent Guam, building visibility within the U.S.-Taiwan business community
- The summit provided opportunities for more conversations and fostering trusted partnerships

- AIT's Commercial Section hosted a reception during SEMICON Taiwan 2025 and invited ASOA members to attend
- The event garnered U.S. state delegations, exhibitors, Taiwanese companies, and AIT's close partners from government and industry to further strengthen U.S.-Taiwan innovation and investment ties
- GTO met with AIT's new commercial Chief, Ms. Janée Pierre-Louis, creating an opportunity for direct engagement with ASOA members

PHILIPPINE AIRLINES LAUNCHES NEW DIRECT FLIGHTS BETWEEN GUAM AND CEBU

Philippine Airlines (PAL) announced the launch of its new direct service between Guam (GUM) and Cebu (CEB) starting December 16, 2025. The new GUM-CEB-GUM route will operate three times weekly, providing passengers with more convenient travel options just in time for the holiday season. The route will be served by the Airbus A321neo, a 199-seater aircraft offering PAL's signature heartfelt service, spacious comfort, and reliability. The Cebu flights compliment PAL's existing Guam-Manila-Guam services, giving passengers greater flexibility to connect to other domestic and international destinations via both Manila and Cebu hubs.

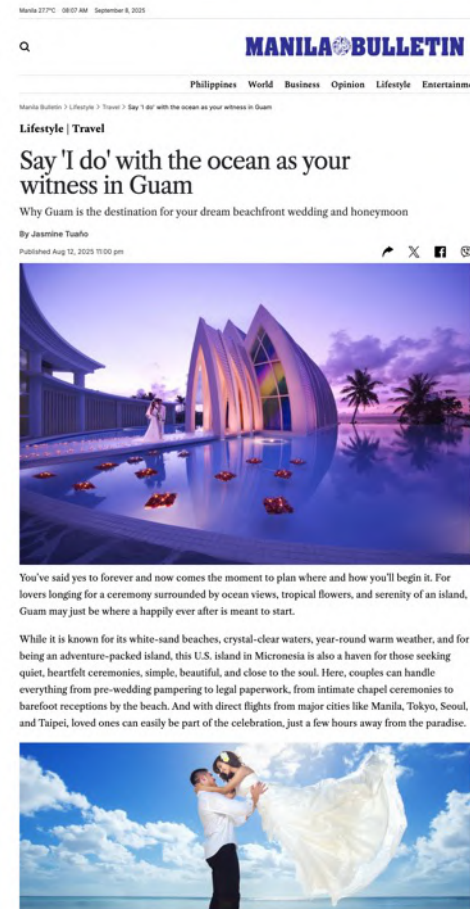
- September 3, 2025






