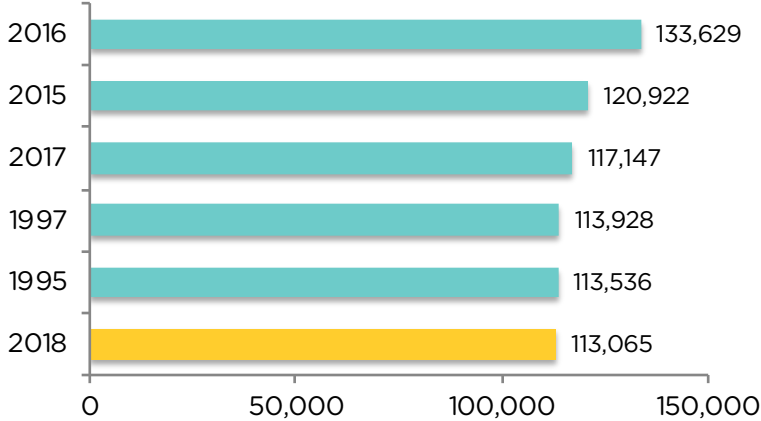

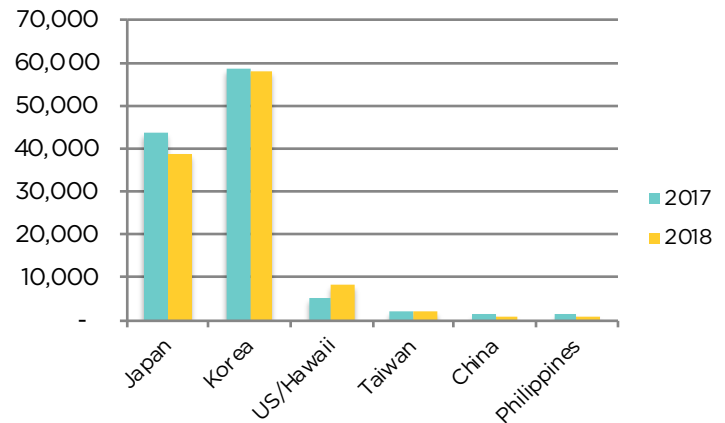
### DID YOU KNOW?

Typhoon Mangkhut caused the cancellation of around **23 flights** or about **6,000 seats** to Guam as it passed over the island.

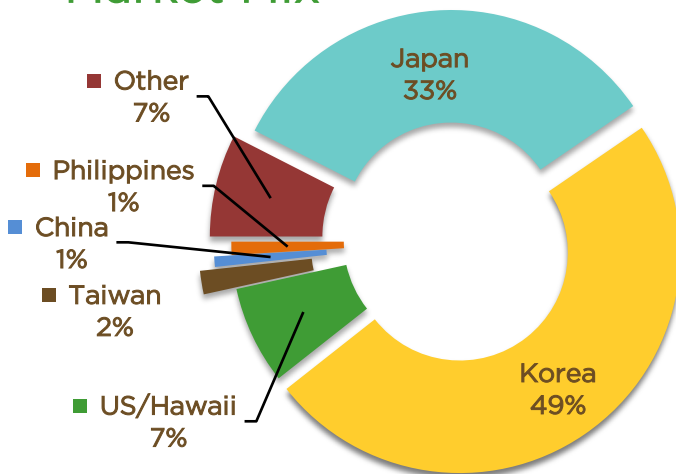

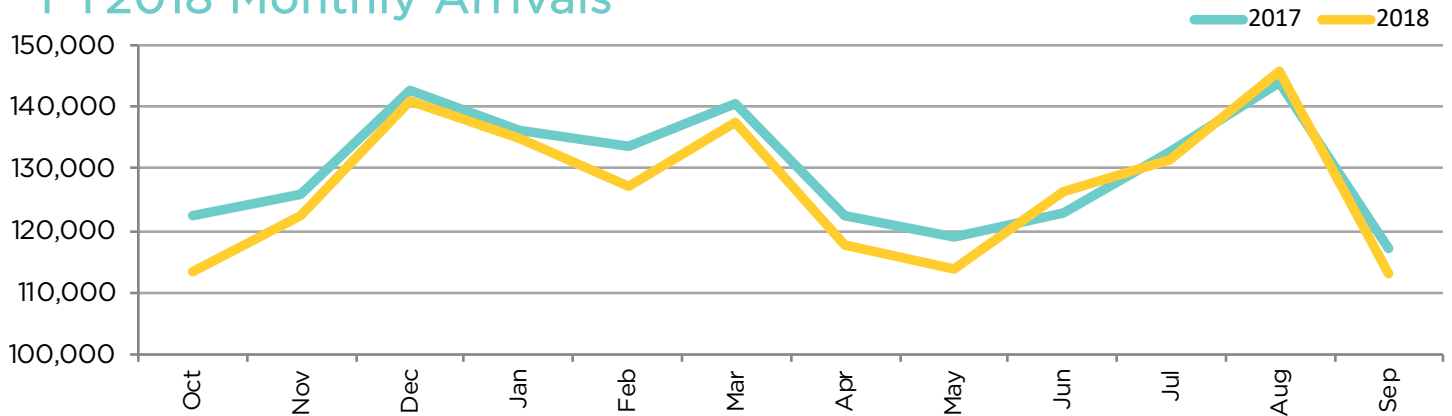

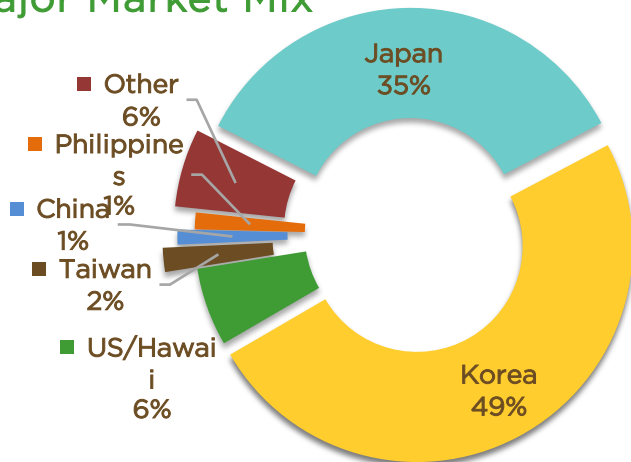
## FY2018 Monthly Arrivals
